

The gardens, which were saved from development in the 1980s and then lived in by Yves Saint Laurent and Pierre Bergé, are known for their bright primary-coloured buildings; the inspiration behind the collection. Using traditional geometric motifs and bold patterns in vivid colours, the "Heriz Majorelle range reflects the vibrancy of the Moroccan oasis. Hossein's rugs are all hand-woven from the finest wools and purest natural silks by expert craftsmen in Iran. There are no mechanical or chemical treatments in the process, and only natural dyes, such as walnut shell, are used. The collection will be available from April 2017. Visit hosseinrezvani.com.

This technique ensures that every item retains the highest level of detail.
